# 2 How do I access the database?

There are two ways to access the projects database from the homepage.

Via the Projects Database button near the top of the page, this will take you to the introductory page;



Or the projects database quick-link in the top right hand corner of the screen;



This will take you straight to the font page of the database.

There are a number of ways you can access the data held on the database. These are;

- Projects Map Search
- Simple Filter Search
- Quick Free Text Search
- Advanced Free Text and Filter Search

This section explains how you can access the project data using these methods.

# 2.1 How do I use the Projects Map Search?

The project map allows you to search for project data by country, region, county, unitary authority or London borough.

The map is divided into Scotland, Northern Ireland, Wales and the nine areas of England covered by the regional government offices.

If you move your mouse over an area of the map it displays the region name and the number of projects in that region.

# 2.1.1 Regional Data

To view a project in a particular region, simply click the corresponding part of the map.

For example, if you click on London you will be presented with a map of London divided into the local boroughs.

The number of projects and a sub-total of the capital value of the projects within London is displayed in top right hand side of the screen.

The projects are listed underneath the map and you will need to scroll down the page to view the whole list.

You can sort your results in ascending or descending order by clicking on any of the column headings.

To view a particular project record, simply click on the row required.

Alternatively you can filter your search further by clicking on a sub-region, in this case a London borough.

To return to the font page click the map of the UK.



# 2.1.2 Sub Regional Data

If you click on your sub-region of interest you are presented with a more narrowly filtered list and an adjusted project count and capital value figure.

Project Details:	The project involved the design and construction of a 4.2 kilometre extension which takes the Docklands Light Railway under the Thames, adding 5 new stations south of the river and 2 reconstructed stations north of the river. Major civil engineering challenges included boring twin tunnels under the Thames and building an 800 metre viaduct across Deptford Creek and the A2. The project was completed 2 months early and to budget. The DLR Lewisham extension provides a vital north/south link with an estimated 500,000 people (in south east London and North Kent) benefiting from the new transport routes to Docklands, the City and Stratford. The Lewisham extension also provides 50 connections to existing transport links. The project has contributed to the ongoing regeneration of East London, offering new employment opportunities for those in the area.						

A project record can contain up to four images of the project. The images are displayed in the main window by clicking on the thumbnail images at the side.

The related links allow the user to view any relevant web material.

You can either scroll down the page to browse the data or click on the shortcut links to take you to the group of data you require.

Some project records contain video footage of the project. If you are connected to the web through a dial up connection you will need to click on the 56k link. If you have broadband you can select the broadband link. Once you click the link a media player will show the video.

# 2.2 How do I use the Simple Filter Search?

To the right of the project map on the front page of the database there are three drop-down lists. You can filter your search by selecting an option from one or more of these lists.

## 2.2.1 Project Category

Currently the database **only** contains details relating to PFI projects in the UK. As the database develops, this will be expanded to take into account other forms of PPP and National Programmes such as Partnerships for Schools.

Therefore, it follows that the options for this drop-down list are;

- PFI
- PPP
- National Programme
- Other Joint Venture

### 2.2.2 Projects Sector

This lists the business service or industry sector most applicable to the projects contained in the database.

The sector listing has two tiers with high level sectors such health and education divided into sub-sectors. For example, education will have Primary, Secondary, Further and Higher among its sub-sectors.

**Note:** Education contains a sub-sector called Primary & Secondary with categorises projects which involve both primary and secondary schools.

# 2.2.3 Project Location

This is the same regional listing as used in the Projects Map. However, it also allows you to search for projects that have a UK Wide scope, i.e. projects which have no specific geographical base but cover the entire UK; and projects that have a region-wide scope, for example roads or transport projects that cover a number of areas.

For example, if you select "All projects within England" you will be presented with a list of all the PFI projects on the database that are based within England. However if you select "England Wide Projects" you'll see a much shorter list of projects that have an England-wide scope.

# 2.2.4 Example Search

To search for PFI hospital developments in London you would select;



The search results are returned in the same format as the Projects Map search and you can sort your results in ascending or descending order by clicking on the column headings.

# 2.3 How do I use the Quick Free Text Search?



The quick search window is always accessible in the top right hand corner of the screen.



This search facility allows you to search the entire website as well as data held on the projects database.

To search for information, enter your search term then click the Go button.

The results are returned as illustrated below.

## 2.3.1 How do I use the Advanced Search Facility?

Click the O Advanced search button in top right hand side of the screen of the Projects Database page. This will take you to the Advanced Search page.

The Advanced Search page allows you to search for information in two separate ways; Free Text Search and Filter Search.

### 2.3.2 Free Text Search

You can enter up to three search terms and join them together using check boxes;

The search engine selects 'and' by default and the more search terms you enter the narrower your search becomes.
